Woman faces charges of drug-trafficking adds fraud charge to troubles

A 39-year-old Clayton Park woman who is scheduled to go on trial for drug trafficking this fall, is now accused of defrauding the Veteran's Memorial Hospital.

Sherri Anne Williams appeared briefly in Halifax provincial court. She is charged with fraud over \$5,000.

The charge stems from a complaint laid by the hospital, according to Halifax Regional Police Const. Jeff Carr. It involves a cheque allegedly cashed by an unauthorized party.

Williams, who lives on Lacewood Drive, is due back in court on July 6. Her trial for drug trafficking is scheduled for Sept. 18.
