**AGREED ORDER OF PROBATION**

This matter comes on for consideration before the Board of Dentistry, State of Oklahoma ("Board"), on August 6, 2010.

**I**  
**FINDINGS OF FACT**

Sadie Renee Lochhead (Hight), R.D.H. ("Respondent"), hereby agrees with the Board of Dentistry ("Board"), State of Oklahoma, as follows:

1. Respondent holds Oklahoma Dental Hygiene License No. 2168, issued July 9, 1999.
2. Respondent practices dental hygiene in Tulsa, Oklahoma and vicinity.
3. Respondent agrees that if evidence was presented, there is clear and convincing evidence on March 4, 2010, Respondent pled Nolo Contendere, in Tulsa County District Court, to the crime of Attempting to Obtain A Controlled Drug By Forged/Altered Prescription, which is a felony.

**II**  
**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The Board hereby finds and as evidenced by her signature appearing below, Respondent agrees and admits to the following conclusions of law:

1. The Board has jurisdiction of this matter by virtue of the provisions of the State Dental Act, 59 O.S. Supp 2003, Sec. 328.1 et seq.
2. By virtue of the provisions of 59 O.S. Supp 2003, Sec. 328.15, the Board has the power and authority to promulgate rules to carry out the provisions of the State Dental Act as the Board deems necessary and proper to protect the dental health of the public.
3. By virtue of the provisions of 59 O.S. Supp 2003, Sec. 328.15(3), the Board is charged with enforcement of the provisions of the State Dental Act.
4. The facts above and Board Findings constitute violations of 59 O.S. Supp 2003, Sec. 328.33(D)(1).

**III**  
**AGREED ORDER OF PROBATION**


Upon adoption of this Order Respondent agrees to serve a probation for two (2) years. Respondent will further agree to the following terms and conditions, to wit:

1. During the period of probation, Respondent will notify the Board in writing of any dental office wherein the practice of dental hygiene occurs within ten (10) days of commencing practice. Respondent will provide all employers a copy of this Agreed Order prior to commencing employment.
2. During the period of probation, Respondent shall not call-in any prescription to any pharmacy.
3. During the period of probation, any violation of the terms and conditions of the Respondent's deferred sentence supervised by the Tulsa County District Attorney's Office shall be considered a violation of this Agreed Order of Probation.
4. During the period of probation, Respondent will appear before the Board when requested to do so after twenty (20) days notice. All written notices shall include date, time, and location.
5. During the period of probation and thereafter, for as long as her dental hygiene license and registration remain effective, Respondent will adhere strictly to all provisions of the State Dental Act of Oklahoma and all Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Board.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED** that SADIE RENEE LOCHHEAD (HIGHT), R.D.H., is placed on probation for a period of two (2) years with terms and conditions as outlined above. Any future violation will result in additional action by the Board.

5. I understand that the Board will consider and adopt this Order at a meeting open to the public.
6. I understand that the Board will report this order to the National Practitioner Data Bank in compliance with Title IV of Public Law 99-660, the Health Care Quality Improvement Act of 1986, otherwise known as the National Practitioner Data Bank.
7. I understand that I may request permission to appear before the Board at the time the Board considers this Order.
8. I acknowledge and attest that no member of the Board, nor any employee, nor attorney of the Board, has coerced, intimidated, or pressured me, in any way whatsoever, to execute this Order.
9. I understand this Order is not in force and effect and is not binding on the Board unless and until adopted by the Board and executed by the Board's President.
10. I understand that this Order shall not be amended or changed unless specifically authorized by the Board of Dentistry in an open meeting.
